Need to Know for Master Candidates


Get Approved: May candidates who are approved to graduate by the School of Graduate Studies Office after January 29th for Spring and April 6th for Summer will not have their name listed in the commencement program.

*NOTE: May commencement is for both Spring and Summer graduating candidates.

Grad Fee: The graduation fee if not already paid, is due by the end of the semester. The fee for Master candidates is \$75.00. Mail your payment directly to the Bursar's Office and clarify that the money is for the graduation fee. Do not send the payment to the School of Graduate Studies or the Records Office. ATTENTION: Your graduation fee is not included in your tuition and must be paid separately. Until this fee is paid you cannot receive your diploma or transcripts.

Cap and Gown: You may pick up your cap and gown from the ECU Bookstore beginning March 13th. Graduation announcements may also be purchased at the ECU bookstore.

Needs: Candidates who need special accommodations for the ceremony because of a physical condition should contact the School of Graduate Studies Office or Records Office as soon as possible.



Commencement Information

Where to be: Commencement exercises for Master's candidates will be held in the Kerr Activity Center Saturday, May 12, 2018. The ceremony will take place at 2:00 p.m. for <u>ALL</u> students completing degree requirements in May.

Master's candidates should report to the ECU Cafeteria at 1:15 p.m. at the south end (behind the partitions) before the ceremony. Instructions relating to the exercises are given at that time. PLEASE BE ON TIME.

For directions to the cafeteria, please see the map on the next page or contact the School of Graduate Studies or the Records Office.

In case of heavy rain, meet in Room 202 Kerr Activity Center. You will be notified of the change by your student email account. Signs will also be posted in the cafeteria.

Please report to the Master's candidates name card table when you arrive.

Caution: <u>Do not</u> bring personal items with you. You will not be allowed to carry any items during the ceremony, including cameras or purses. They will be collected and taken to the Records Office to be picked up immediately following the ceremony. In the case of cold weather or drizzle, a table will be available for coats and umbrellas as you enter the stairs at the Kerr Center.

Remember: Master's candidates will receive their degrees as a group prior to the bachelor's candidate. Please be prepared to participate in the entire ceremony. Candidates should not leave until the commencement exercises are completed in their entirety.

Commencement and Parking Map

Before graduation ceremonies take place, graduates will meet in the ECU cafeteria which is designated with a YELLOW star on the map below. Entrances are shown with GREEN arrows. The circle drive is shown by a BLUE arrow and is available to those who would like to be dropped off to enter the cafeteria. Commencement will take place in the building designated with the ORANGE star.




Parking on the day of commencement will be available in all areas marked with a GREEN star. The YELLOW arrows indicate parking areas that are recommended for convenience.





Graduation Attire

- We encourage you to wear comfortable, yet professional, dress attire under your gown rather than casual clothing to ensure that our graduates represent themselves and ECU with the utmost respectability.
- Heels are not recommended as candidates do proceed down the 14th street hill and three flights of indoor stairs. See pictures below if you are unfamiliar with 14th street and the stairs inside the Kerr Activities Center.
- Corsages, ornamental accessories, or **lettering on the hat may <u>NOT</u> be worn**.
- Honors cords and organizational sashes are allowed. Since Master's students are required to hold a 3.00-4.00 GPA, there is **NOT** an honors cord.
- Master's candidates tassel will stay on the left side.
- **<u>Do not</u>** bring personal items with you. You will not be allowed to carry any items during the ceremony, including cameras or purses. They will be collected and taken to the Records Office to be picked up immediately following the ceremony. In the case of cold weather or drizzle, a table will be available for coats and umbrellas as you enter the stairs at the Kerr Center.
- You can bring your hood and we will help you put it on correctly.







Etiquette for Commencement

To promote a respectful, comfortable, and enjoyable experience for graduates and their guests, all attendees need to observe the following guidelines.

- Put your cell phone on vibrate or silent during the ceremony.
- Keep cheering respectful, avoiding disruptive outbursts to allow the families and guests of other graduates to hear their graduates' names when they are read.
- Do not leave until the entire ceremony has ended, and participate in the recessional.


Because Master's candidates will receive their degrees as a group prior to the bachelor candidates, please be prepared to participate in the entire ceremony. Candidates should not leave until the commencement exercises are completed in their entirety.





Tips you will WANT to remember

- When you cross the stage you will be handed a diploma cover. It will not contain your diploma.
- Lettering on your cap is **NOT** allowed.
- Master's candidates tassel will stay on the left side.
- There will be someone to assist you with putting on your master hood.
- You absolutely must have a partner in the processional that you walk beside, but it may not be the same person that you walk down the hill beside.
- If you wish to sit next to a specific person, they need to be directly in front or behind you but it is impossible to calculate for row splits.
- As you approach the stage, the Alumni Association will be pinning alumni pins on you. If you do not wish to be pinned, hold out your hand for yours.



When receiving your diploma, reach for the diploma cover with your left hand and shake hands with your right hand. This will ensure that a clear picture can be taken of the diploma cove and minimize confusion. We want you to have the best picture of this moment that you have worked so hard for!



Graduation Photography

A professional photographer from Genesse Photo will be at the ceremony to take photographs of each candidate as you walk across the stage and then another photo as you exit the stage, standing between the American Flag and the State Flag. A proof will be mailed to you at the address listed on your Diploma Application with information about purchasing photo packages.
