Requirements for Bachelor's Degrees

- 30 hours at ECU
- 60 hours at four-year institution
- 40 hours upper-level courses
- OSRHE computer proficiency requirement

I. General Education 40 hours

A maximum of 12 hours may be counted in both the major/related work and general education.

II. Major in Interdisciplinary Studies 45 hours

A. Required Core Courses 12 hours

- IDS 3113 Interdisciplinary Studies
- IDS 3123 Professional Field Experience I
- IDS 4123 Professional Field Experience II
- IDS 4723 Senior Project

B. Required in Interdisciplinary Studies Major 33 hours

Complete thirty-three (33) hours of course work approved in the student's Individual Learning Plan (ILP). The ILP must reflect a coherent plan of study in support of the student's academic and career goals.

The ILP must include at least eighteen (18) hours of credit in the major area at ECU, and at least fifteen (15) hours must be upper division credit.

IV. Electives 35 hours

An elective course is any college-level course not required by the degree that is utilized to reach the 120 credit hours required for degree completion. Elective courses are chosen according to the interest of the student and can be used in completion of a minor, certificate, or additional major.
