The Certificate in Entrepreneurship provides students with the knowledge and skills needed to start and manage new business ventures. Coursework introduces foundational business concepts and entrepreneurial thinking, along with the opportunity to focus on business planning or venture creation. Elective hours allow students to further develop skills in accounting, business, or information technology management. This certificate complements a variety of majors and prepares students for careers in entrepreneurship, small business management, and innovation-driven organizations.
