Certificate in Managerial Accounting (21 Credit Hours)



The Certificate in Managerial Accounting provides students with a strong foundation in cost analysis, financial decision-making, and internal reporting. Coursework focuses on managerial and cost accounting, intermediate accounting, and financial management, equipping students with the skills needed to support organizational planning and control. Elective options allow students to expand their expertise in areas such as auditing, ethics, information systems, or economics. This certificate complements business-related majors and prepares students for careers in accounting, financial analysis, and managerial decision-making. (*Curriculum updated: AY 2025-26*)
