Syllabus Night	Syllabus Night teaches students how to use their syllabi to stay organized, manage time, and understand expectations. It helps build confidence, reduce stress, and sets students up for a strong start to the semester!	The event happens the first week of class. Watch for ads and announcements!
Retention Alerts	Professors submit an alert for students struggling with attendance, grades, or participation. We then contact the student via text, phone, or email to offer support.	Watch for messages from the ASC. We will be happy to help you academically or refer you to other support services.
ACCUPLACER Testing	If a student scored below a 19 on the ACT or did not take the ACT, they can take remedial classes or they can try to test out of that requirement by taking the ACCUPLACER placement test.
