

Tom Darter *Class of 1973*

Tom Darter is known by many titles. Coach, teacher and entrepreneur are all included.

Darter began a small start up in his garage in 1980 called Jet Specialty, Inc., which has grown into one of the largest independent oilfield supply and fabrication companies with more than 400 employees and 20 locations throughout Oklahoma, Texas and New Mexico.

After graduating from Boise City High School in 1969, Darter received a football scholarship from ECU. He played on the Tiger football team from 1969-1973 and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Education.

After college, he embarked on a 5-year journey teaching and coaching in Wayne, Oklahoma; San Marcos, Texas; and Odessa, Texas.

Darter resigned from education in 1978 and found he was quite good as a salesman in Odessa.

After a couple years, Darter wanted to venture out and start his own business, that being Jet Specialty, Inc.

Darter married his wife, Cathy Tweedy, in 1973. The couple currently reside in Boerne, Texas, where they have raised their three children: Chad Darter, Courtney Bruce, and Clint Darter who all live in Boerne and work in the family business. The Darters have nine grandchildren.



DISTINGUISHE Alumna

Paula Kedy, a 1976 East Central University graduate and 2023 Distinguished Alumna, serves as the Aerospace and Aviation Education Coordinator for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission. She works with school districts, universities, and industry leaders in the development of aviation STEM programming designed to prepare students for careers in the aerospace industry.

In 1973 as a student at ECU, she served in student government and in leadership positions across campus. Kedy credits strong and effective instruction skills to faculty members she was able to emulate in her career.

In 2004, Kedy was named the Oklahoma Supreme Court Teacher of the Year and also holds the titles of Moore West Mid-High Teacher of the Year, the Ada City School District Teacher of the Year Award and was named a semifinalist for Oklahoma Teacher of the Year. She also served as the President of the Oklahoma Council of Teachers of English.

In 2016, her journey with the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA) began. At the time, she was Executive Director of Academics for the Ada City School District and attended an AOPA symposium in Seattle where she applied to field test the new "You Can Fly" High School aviation Curriculum.

In 2017, Ada High School was the only school in Oklahoma selected to field test the curriculum and the Ada City School district quickly began to develop a program that drew national attention.

In 2020, she was asked to join the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission as the Aerospace and Aviation Education Coordinator. Kedy works with school leaders across Oklahoma in the development of high school aviation programs through the implementation of the 'You Can Fly' curriculum. She serves on the National Steering Committee for AOPA "You Can Fly" High School Curriculum as well as on advisory boards for the University of Oklahoma Sooner Flight Academy, the Southeastern University School of Aviation Sciences, and the Spartan College of Aeronautics. She also received the Oklahoma STEM Innovator Award from the Tulsa Regional STEM Alliance and Tulsa Flight Night Program in 2019 for her work in advancing aviation STEM education in Oklahoma. Kedy encourages young women to participate in "Girls in Aviation" and "Women in Aviation" programs in Oklahoma. Kedy and her husband, Mark, reside in Ada. Their son, Scott, and daughter-in-law, Audra, live in Oklahoma City where Scott practices law and Audra serves as the Senior Associate Commissioner for the Great American Athletic Conference.

Vicky Petete Class of 1979

A certified public accountant by trade, Vicky Petete has been closely involved with ECU and the Ada community. Upon graduation from college in 1979, Petete began her public accounting career at Horne & Company, PC in Ada, which allowed her to see firsthand public service at work. In 1991, Petete began working for First National Bank and Trust which later became Vision Bank. Bill Horne continued as her mentor as he served as the Chairman of the Board of Vision Bank. Petete plans to retire in June 2023.

For over 40 years, Petete has assisted the School of

Business at ECU and its students. Petete has been an advisor to the Accounting Club and has organized many activities specific to furthering the knowledge of students in accounting.

When the National Association of the State Board of Accountancy (NASBA) first developed the Center for the Public Trust (CPT) and began developing student chapters at universities throughout the country, Petete was instrumental in organizing the chapter and getting it approved as an authorized organization at ECU. Since then, she has served as advisor to the chapter and sponsored ECU students attending the StudentCPT Leadership Conference. In 2019, she was awarded the StudentCPT Campus Being a Difference Award.

Petete worked with ECU faculty to develop a Master in Accounting degree. Petete then completed the curriculum and earned the Master of Accounting degree from ECU in 2011. Petete also mentors ECU accounting students as well as sharing her life's experiences and knowledge. She has also assisted many students outside of the mentoring program to find potential employers and internships in Ada and throughout the State of Oklahoma. Petete also assisted with the development and instruction of a financial literacy class that became part of the core curriculum at ECU.

Petete has served on the ECU Foundation Board since 2012, currently serving as a board member and previously served as chairman, past-chair and treasurer. Petete has also been involved with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public Accountants and was named Outstanding Member in Industry in 1997, received Distinguished CPA in 2006, was awarded the OSCPA Public Service Award in 2010. In 2012, she was named to the OSCPA Oklahoma Accounting Hall of Fame and she was named as one of the first OSCPA Path Finder

Award recipients in 2019.


Petete was nominated by the OSCPA and was confirmed by Governor Brad Henry to become a member of the Oklahoma Accountancy Board in July 2004. She completed two five-year terms in June 2014 and served in various roles during that time.

Organizations Petete has been involved with include the People's Electric Cooperative Board, Mercy Health Oklahoma Communities Board (Mercy West), Rotary Club of Ada, Byng Excellence in Education Foundation and Ada Area Chamber of Commerce. She has also been named one of the 50 Women in the State of Oklahoma Making a Difference.

WAYS TO GIVE







Gifts to the Foundation, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization under the IRS code, are tax-deductible to the extent of the law

GIFTS OF SECURITIES

These gifts include stocks, bonds, mutual funds, and IRAs, and also are available immediately to impact the work of the Foundation.

GIFTS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

Personal property can include coin collections, antique cars, gun collections, artwork, etc.

GIFTS OF REAL PROPERTY

Real estate, homes, business property and farmland that has grown in value can result in tax advantages through a charitable gift to the Foundation.

GIFTS OF TRUSTS

This can include charitable remainder trusts, unitrusts, lead trusts, family trusts, annuity trusts, etc., which can avoid capital gains taxes and provide an annual income for life.

GIFTS OF BEQUESTS

At a donor's death, gifts directed by a will or a living trust are deducted from the most highly taxed portion of the donor's estate, resulting in less taxes and a larger distribution of the estate to the heirs. This is perhaps the most basic and flexible of estate planning instruments.

GIFTS OF INSURANCE

By assigning ownership to the Foundation or making the Foundation the beneficiary of a life insurance policy that is no longer needed for its original purpose (such as sheltering children's education), a donor can make a substantial gift at a low cost and take an immediate income tax deduction for the value of the policy. A donor then can contribute an amount equal to the policy's premiums to the Foundation and deduct that gift as a charitable contribution. Proceeds of the policy will pass to the Foundation free of estate taxes.

The President's Circle is an exclusive group of individuals and businesses who provide targeted support for the advancement of East Central University. This important group provides the University and the President with access to non-designated funds that can be used to enhance educational experiences and opportunities for students,








ECU Foundation Scholarship Support


