## **Application Checklist**

You may email them to [nurse\\_sec@ecok.edu](mailto:nurse_sec@ecok.edu). **Admission status notifications will be sent out approximately 4 weeks after the admission cycle closes, via the email address you provided on your application.** Please do not call or email the office to ask about your status; we cannot release this information over the phone. We are using that time to review applications and get the notifications out as quickly as possible.

## **Section C: Application & Admission Acknowledgement**

Please be sure **NOT** to confuse the ECU application for the application to the nursing program. They are two completely separate applications, and **due dates may be different than those of the university.**

**Nursing program** applications must be received in the nursing office by the designated cutoff date. If this date falls on a weekend (Saturday or Sunday), or on a public holiday, the due date will be the following business day. Cutoff dates for **submitting the nursing program application** are as follows:

**For spring semesters, September 1<sup>st</sup>**

**For fall semesters, March 1<sup>st</sup>**

Acceptance letters are sent out via email approximately four weeks from the cycle closing date. If you have not been accepted to ECU by that time, you will receive a provisional letter, pending your acceptance.

ECU applications must be completed/submitted to the portal by the designated cutoff date, **to include all required application documents.** Cutoff dates for **applying to ECU, with all required documentation** are as follows:

For spring semesters: **Applications & all documents must be in the portal no later than November 1<sup>st</sup>.**

For fall semesters: **Applications & all documents must be in the portal no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>**

Again, all applications and related/required materials must be submitted to your portal by the cutoff date to receive full acceptance and additional program information. If you have not applied to ECU, and/or submitted all required documents, by the cutoff date, your application will be voided.

## **Section D: Transcript Requirement Acknowledgement**

As part of the application process, you **MUST** submit transcripts from **each college and/or university** you have attended. These documents are used to determine your program, cumulative, and institution (retention) GPA based on currently completed courses, as well as assist in the assignment of points during the scoring process. Initially, you may submit unofficial transcripts, but must submit **official** ones prior to the start of the admitted semester. Failure to submit all transcripts may result in the application being voided.

- If you are a **current ECU student** and have submitted your transcripts to the Admissions Office &/or your application portal, you **DO NOT** need to resubmit. Please make us aware of this when you submit your application.
- If you are a transfer or new student to ECU and have submitted your transcripts to the Admissions Office &/or your application portal, you **DO NOT** need to resubmit. Please make us aware of this when you submit your application.

- Official transcripts may be included with your nursing program application packet, or delivered in person as long as they remain sealed. If you are having official transcripts mailed, please have them sent to **ECU School of Nursing, 1100 E 14<sup>th</sup> Street PMB V-8, Ada, OK 74820**  
Transcripts **MUST** be received, regardless of method, no later than the application cutoff dates
- **For classes that you are currently enrolled in OUTSIDE of ECU; these will require official transcripts to be submitted to the SoN upon the completion of the current semester. We will forward these to Admissions for you. You may send an unofficial while waiting for grades to post.**

#### GPA

As part of the application process, transcripts are evaluated and used to determine your program, cumulative, and institution (retention) GPA based on currently completed courses, as well as assist in the assignment of points during the scoring process.

- Any “D” or “F” that you have made at East Central University or any other institution attended, in any course listed on the School of Nursing GPA Form may be used to calculate your School of Nursing GPA.
- Any “D”, “F”, or “W” that you have made at East Central University or any other institution attended, will be used in the assignment of points during the scoring process.
- Any “D” or “F” that you have made at East Central University or any other institution attended, may be used to calculate your cumulative and institution (retention) GPA.
- If you have a “D”, “F” or a “W” that does not show up on this form at this time, the admissions committee may add the “D”, “F” or “W” to this form and recalculate your School of Nursing, cumulative, and institution (retention) GPAs.

#### Grades

For the purpose of nursing; To maintain the integrity of program policies, the following will be considered while advising, reviewing transcripts and applications, etc. A grade of “P” denotes course completion with a passing grade but is NOT considered to be equivalent to a grade of “C” toward any admission points and may not be considered for program retention requirement.

#### CLEP Exams

At ECU, students can receive credit for the College Board’s College-Level Examination Program (CLEP; Subject exams only). All credit for awarded will be transcribed with a P-grade (Passed). Unless previously accepted and transcribed at another Oklahoma regionally accredited institution, an original copy of the credit by examination must be submitted to ECU.

### **Section F: Program & Clinical Requirements**

Below is a list of clinical and program requirements that, once you have been accepted which will need to be completed **by the designated due date**. Once you have been accepted, you will receive additional information on these requirements and due dates.

- Background Check (Est Cost \$110.00, to include drug screen)
- Drug Screen
- CPR – Must be American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers
  
- **Immunizations:** Records must be legible, with name and date given visible. Statements such as “as a child,” “up to date,” or “not needed,” are not acceptable
  - Annual Influenza –for current flu season
  - Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis (Tdap)
  - Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR)
  - Varicella (Chicken Pox)
  - Hepatitis B
  - Initial 2-Step Tuberculin Skin Test OR Negative Tspot blood test OR Negative QuantiFERON blood test
    - If previous or current positive test results, Clearance for Public Contact must be obtained from the Health Department
  - COVID-19 vaccination - complete series (boosters are not required at this time)

#### **Vaccination Statement**

The clinical facilities that have agreed to provide experiential education within the ECU School of Nursing program curriculum require designated vaccinations to participate in clinical and/or instruction at their facility. ECU SoN has no authority to waive the clinical sites vaccinations requirements. The clinical facilities are also responsible for the evaluation and administration of requests for exemptions to their respective vaccination requirements, which may vary among clinical facilities. **Due to these facility vaccination requirements, unvaccinated students may not be able to satisfy a required component of the curriculum and therefore may be unable to complete the nursing program.** Any student wishing to be exempt must contact the Clinical Coordinator, or in their absence, the Director. They will also be responsible for contacting their assigned clinical facility(ies) for the waiver process. Copies of any approved waivers must be submitted to the SoN, and the student will be required to sign a disclaimer acknowledging understanding.

It is highly recommended that the admitted student complies with all vaccinations for uninterrupted progress through the program.

### Section G: Admission Requirements & Consideration

Please remember that every application is reviewed and considered, **with any exceptions to admission requirements approved on a case-by-case basis by the Director and committee of faculty.** Please talk with your advisor and/or the nursing office if you are missing/deficient in any requirement, about submitting your application.

- Meet both ECU and SoN admission requirements and application deadlines; following the processes as instructed.
- Once admitted to the nursing program, complete/maintain all remaining requirements, related to clinical, attestations, and accreditation, to include attending the mandatory cohort orientation, held the Wednesday prior to the start of the semester.
- GPA: minimum of 2.7/4.0 (program and cumulative/grad/retention) on all course work completed at the time of application.
- HESI A2: overall composite score of 75% achieved within two attempts. **If you do not score a 75% composite on the first attempt, you MUST take a second attempt to be considered.**
- Minimum of 24 hours of gen eds/required related work courses, or the equivalent thereof completed at the time of application, or that will be completed prior to the admission term.
- The following courses must be completed prior to beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the program, and must be passed with a grade of “C” or higher:
  - English Composition I & II
  - Functions & Modeling OR College Algebra
  - Chemical Principles OR General Chemistry (must have lab)
  - General Biology (must have lab)
  - Human Anatomy OR Anatomy & Physiology I (must have lab)
  - Basic Nutrition
  - General Psychology
- If accepted, all additional required related work must be completed prior to beginning the third semester of the program, and must be passed with a grade of “C” or higher. Human Physiology (OR A& P II), and Microbiology must have a lab.
- If you do not score the benchmark on the Math section of the HESI, you will be required to take the Medical Math class with the other 1<sup>st</sup> semester nursing courses.

### Application Scoring

The application scoring rubric is not published, and is subject to change per admission cycle, based on assessment. Application scoring is based on points that may include, but not limited to: GPA (program and Cumulative/Grad /Retention), required related work (math and science courses) grades, earned degrees, relative experience, licensures, and certifications (found on application; with verification), and hours earned at ECU.

## Section I: HESI A2 Entrance Exam

Instructions regarding the HESI A2 can be found at [Major in Nursing](#). You **MUST** take the HESI A2 entrance exam offered through ECU SoN. No other exam results will be accepted. A breakdown in exam content can be found on page 10. **If you DO NOT score a 75% composite on the first attempt, you are required to take a second attempt as well. If you score below a 75% composite and do not take a second exam, your application will not be considered.** While we look for a minimum composite score of 75%, each application is reviewed and considered. Please remember that admission is competitive, and that exam scores are a high consideration.

The cost of the exam is approximately \$90.00 per attempt. You are allowed two attempts for each application cycle, and the results are valid for 12-months from the date the exam was taken. **There is no prescribed wait time between attempts**, the exception being any scheduling requirements for ProctorU. Candidates will be allowed 6 hours (360 mins) to complete the exam.

All candidates taking this **HESI A2 exam understand their results will be automatically sent** to the Director, East Central University School of Nursing for admission consideration. Adherence to academic integrity is expected of all candidates. A founded breach of academic integrity of any kind, discovered prior to or after testing and/or submission of application, may result in a candidate's ineligibility to apply/be admitted to the program.

Incident reports are received from ProctorU for any noted deviations from the instructions. All incident reports will be investigated as a possible academic integrity violation and may result in the application being voided.

Candidates must adhere to the following instructions:

- During pre-checks, show a valid, current, English ID, with the name matching the exam registration. The ID information must be clearly visible to the proctor
- During pre-checks, perform a 360-degree scan of the room and show a clear desk with only the allowed resources: (cell phones and smartwatches are NOT permitted during testing)
  - (1) sheet of paper inside a transparency sleeve used with a dry erase marker or Kleenex  
OR a whiteboard
  - (1) bottle of water with the label removed is permitted
- Remain in view of the camera at all times, unless taking a bathroom break
- Be alone in the room for the entirety of the exam
- Bathroom breaks are permitted, with the understanding the exam time does not pause. If you do take a break, **DO NOT STOP OR LOG OUT OF YOUR EXAM**
- Complete all sections of the exam for the score to be considered, to include the Learner Profile and Critical Thinking

## Section J: HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam Information

The **HESI Admission Assessment (A2)** tests program applicants in three main academic areas – **English Language, Math, & Science**. This test is designed to assess the academic and personal readiness of prospective students in nursing and health professions. Two additional exams are **required**; Learner Profile and Critical Thinking.

The **English Language** portion of the test includes the following sub-categories:

- **Reading Comprehension:** Provides reading scenarios in order to measure reading comprehension, identifying the main idea, finding meaning of words in context, passage comprehension, making logical inferences, etc.
- **Vocabulary and General Knowledge:** Contains vocabulary terms that are commonly used in both general English-speaking settings and in health care fields.
- **Grammar:** Contains basic grammar, including parts of speech, important terms and their uses, commonly occurring grammatical errors, etc.

The **Math** portion of the test covers the following:

- **Basic Math Skills:** Focuses on math skills needed for health care fields, including basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, fractions, decimals, ratio and proportion, household measures, general math facts, etc.

The **Science** portion of the test includes the following sub-categories:

- **Biology:** Covers biology basics, water, biological molecules, metabolism, cells, cellular respiration, photosynthesis, etc.
- **Chemistry:** Contains test items that cover matter, chemical equations and reactions, the periodic table, atomic structure, nuclear chemistry, chemical bonding, etc.
- **Anatomy and Physiology:** Provides coverage of general terminology and anatomical structures and systems.

### **HESI A2 Exam Registration**

We will be using ProctorU for on-line proctoring of your HESI A2 exams. You must create both a **ProctorU** and a **MyEvolve** account to be able to register for and take your exam. The [HESI Test-Taking Student Portal](#) is available to walk you through how to create both accounts and schedule your exam. Please follow the instructions carefully.

**If you have a ProctorU account with an institution other than ECU, you will need to add a new enrollment with Elsevier – HESI, per the instructions on the portal.**

When you create your Evolve account, if you are a current ECU student, please use your ECU email when creating it. If you are not a current ECU student, use your personal email (not another institution). **IMPORTANT NOTE: Your username will be auto generated and will be a combination of your first initial, your last name, and a number or series of numbers.**

### **HESI A2 Scheduling**

Continue to follow the instructions on the portal to schedule an exam. **IMPORTANT....**

- In the dropdown labeled “Confirm your Institution” you select “Elsevier-HESI”
- In the dropdown labeled “Select a Term” – search for and select East Central University
- In the dropdown labeled “Select your Exam” – select the following:
  - First attempt: SP24 Cycle 1<sup>st</sup> Attempt
  - Second attempt: SP24 Cycle 2<sup>nd</sup> Attempt
- You must pay for your exam at the time of scheduling or the exam will be cancelled by ProctorU

### **HESI A2 Preparation - TO DO prior to exam day**

- You must download the [Guardian Browser](#)
- Check the [Minimum Requirements](#) here
- Using the link on the portal, test your equipment
- .If any part of your equipment fails the test, you can start a live chat with our representatives by clicking the “Need Help? Chat Now!” button in the lower right of your account screen
