- ⇒ A student transferring with an Associate degree in Arts or Science from SSC fulfills ECU's general education requirement by transferring his or her credit to East Central University. Transferring credit for general education does not eliminate or otherwise affect any of the following ECU requirements: (1) prerequisites; (2) specific requirements in majors, minors or related work in these areas; or (3) the requirements for teacher certification. - ⇒ A student must earn <u>at least 60 semester hours</u>, excluding physical activity courses, at a baccalaureate degree granting institution.
- $\Rightarrow$  A student must earn <u>at least 120 credit hours</u> that apply to an ECU Bachelor's degree.
